TERMS AND CONDITIONS AND ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

These terms, conditions and eligibility criteria apply to individuals who have been nominated for a 2017 Tasmanian Volunteering Award listed above. Nominations close at 5pm, 3 March 2017, finalists will be announced on 3 April 2017 with the Awards presented on 8 May 2017.

1. Entry into Competition

All nominators agree to have read, understood and accepted the following terms, conditions and eligibility criteria before submitting a nomination.

2. Nominations

2.1 The following terms apply to nominations:

- Self-nominations are accepted;
- Nominations that are late, incomplete or not received will not be accepted;
- Only one category can be nominated for on an application form. The same person can be nominated for different Awards only if nominated on separate application forms.
- The activities for which nominees are being nominated for must have been carried out in a voluntary, unpaid capacity.

2.2 Submission of nominations

Nominations can be submitted by the following groups:

- Not-for-profit organisations;
- Local and state government agencies;
- Business groups; and
- Other individuals; or
- Themselves

The nominator must know the nominee. Nominators may nominate a family member.

3. Eligibility Criteria for Nominees

Individual Nominees must meet the following requirements:

- Nominee must be residing in Tasmania;
- The voluntary activities must have occurred in Tasmania;
- The volunteering activities must have been done within the Award period April 2016 to March 2017.
- The organisation which the nominee was volunteering for must have been operating within the Award period April 2016 to March 2017.
- The voluntary work must benefit communities in Tasmania

4. Eligibility of Prizes

Three finalists will be chosen from the entries received for this Award by an independent judging panel chaired by Volunteering Tasmania. If the scores of the individual judges create a tie-breaker situation, the nominations will be assessed against [the National Standards for Volunteer Involvement](#).

All finalists must be in attendance at the Awards ceremony, or send a representative, to be eligible to receive their prizes.

The following individuals are not eligible for prizes:

- Staff and volunteers who worked on the creation and implementation of this Awards competition, and staff and volunteers of Volunteering Tasmania;
- Any immediate family member of a staff member or volunteer who worked on the creation and implementation of this Awards competition, and immediate family members of staff and volunteers of Volunteering Tasmania.

Staff, volunteers and immediate family members of an Awards sponsor are eligible and invited to enter a category their organisation is sponsoring. For more information on the judging process please visit this [page](#).
